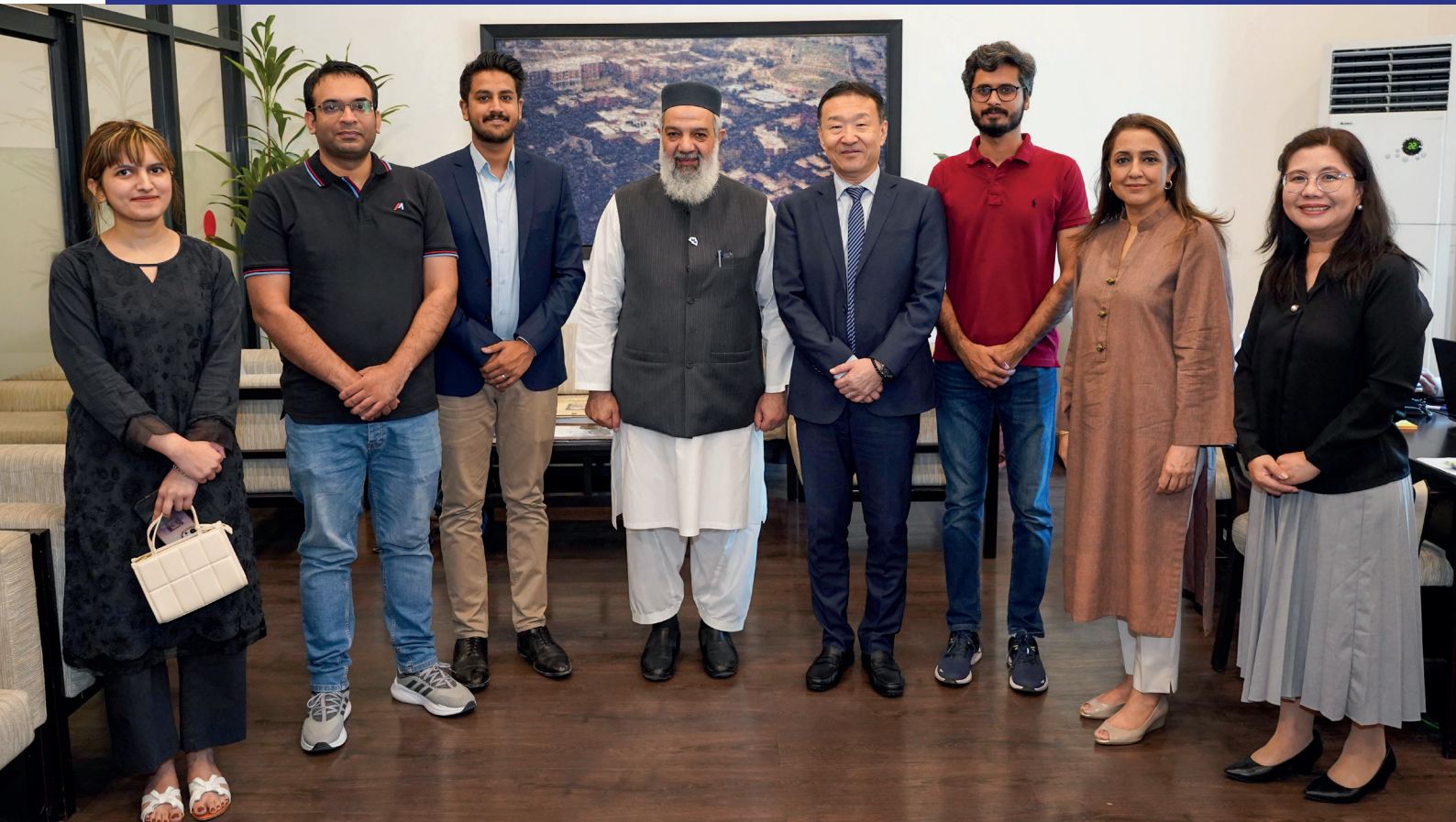


Bridging Borders: LUMS Hosts Scottish Delegation to Explore Academic Collaboration
